

# Citizens of Double Churches Community: Request for Action December 2, 2019

We the citizens of the Double Churches community located in Franklin County Georgia do hereby petition the Franklin County Board of Commissioners, Thomas Bridges, Robert Franklin, Jason Macomson, Ryan Swails and Eddie Wester to:

1. Test wells within a 1 mile radius of the Georgia Renewable Power Plant aka Franklin Biomass Power Plant at the entire expense of Franklin County starting January 1, 2020 to establish a baseline of water conditions and will test, at the county's expense, twice a year until the Georgia Renewable Power Plant aka Franklin Biomass Power Plant ceases to exist regardless of any reports from EPD. If any well is found to not be safe for consumption, Franklin County will pay for said well owner to receive county water. This will include having water lines run from county pipeline to their residence. This will be done in a timely manner.
2. Adopt and act upon the Georgia Nuisance Law and the Franklin County Noise Hazard. This is in accordance with Georgia State Law O.C.G.A. 41-1-1 and Franklin County zoning regulations page 11, Noise Hazards.
3. Defer **any** and **all** property taxes for all citizens being affected by Georgia Renewable Power aka Franklin Biomass Power Plant. This affect could include any noise pollution, air pollution, water pollution, killing of trees, decline in property values, and overall loss in quality of life. We are asking for this to begin in the year 2020 and continue until such said plant closes permanently with NO repercussions of back taxes.

Franklin County Board of Commissioners, you are being asked to take immediate action for the safety, health, well being and quality of life for the citizens that you have taken a vow to serve and protect.
